### Pool Info

- Coaches' CHECK-IN—30 minutes before playing. Captains of first match will be called 10 minutes prior to play.
- The pool will play only two sets against each opponent; **sets will start at 4-4** and have no cap.
- Warm-ups will be 4-4 for the first match and 3-3 for later matches. Serve within your time. No shared back court.
- R-1(up official will be provided) while teams will provide R-2, Score/Flip, Libero Tracker, and 2 Line Judges
  - Have your team ready to officiate at the conclusion of the previous match; report to the R1 official.

### Tie Breaker Process

#### Two-Way Tie Breaker Process

- Consider 1<sup>st</sup> – Head to Head Sets
- Consider 2<sup>nd</sup> – Head to Head Points
- Consider 3<sup>rd</sup> – Overall Point Differential
- Consider 4<sup>th</sup> – coin flip

For advancement – If still tied after head to head points, play one set to 15.

#### Three-Way Tie Breaker Process

- Consider 1<sup>st</sup> – Overall Point Differential
- Consider 2<sup>nd</sup> – One set to 15, bye determined by coin flip if all three teams are still tied on OPD

For advancement – Top team is determined by OPD and then coin flip. Remaining two teams then play one set to 15.

### Bracket Play

The **top four teams in each pool will advance** to bracket play. 1<sup>st</sup> and 2<sup>nd</sup> in each pool along with the two best third place finishers based on overall point differential advance to gold while the remaining 3<sup>rd</sup> and all 4<sup>th</sup> advance to silver. Teams finishing 5<sup>th</sup> will be finished after pool play; no officiating in bracket is required. Medals will be awarded for 1<sup>st</sup> and 2<sup>nd</sup> in gold and 1<sup>st</sup> only in silver. Teams will play 2/3 with no cap on any set, but the 3<sup>rd</sup> set, if necessary, will be to 15, and teams will switch sides at 8.

**Warm-up balls will NOT be provided. There should NOT be volleyballs outside of the gym floor area.**
